PLEASE READ THIS ENTIRE DOCUMENT BEFORE COMPLETING: Guests must be currently enrolled in High School, or a recent Highland High School graduate, and **not more than 20 years of age**. Middle School students will not be permitted. All guests must be prepared to present an official photo ID (driver's license or state ID, school ID, etc.) and present it if requested. Suspected fraudulent identifications will be confiscated and given to police. Students or guests who depart the event are presumed to have left for the duration. There is no re-entry. Highland students may only bring one guest. Administration reserves the right to inspect all packages, administer random alcohol or sobriety tests, or deny admittance to any individual whose appearance or demeanor appears inconsistent with appropriate conduct. This conduct includes, but is not limited to school-appropriate dancing. Students will not be permitted to dance in any sexually-explicit manner. **Please note: This is a school event, and any school policy regarding drugs and/or alcohol will apply at the dance.** Any Student that leaves before 9:30 will have a recorded time of exit and parents will have access to this information upon request.

The following dress code is in effect for all persons attending this event: SEMI-FORMAL, no hats, no jeans.
