Transportation Department

Over the summer, the Transportation Dept. will be updating and adjusting the bus routes for the 2019-20 school year. We want to remind everyone that if your students need transportation to and/or from a location other than your home address, we must have a Bus Permit Form to process that. These can be found on-line in the Transportation and Maintenance page. For elementary school students, the alternate address must be within your school's boundaries. Approved bus permits are good for one school year. If you submitted a form for 2018-19, it will expire on June 1, 2019, and you will need to submit another for next year.

Please submit forms as soon as possible to your school office for approval, preferably before the start of the school year. It can take two or more days for this information to be processed depending on how many are received, to allow time for routing and informing both the home bus driver and the alternate address bus driver.
