Late Arrival / Early Release Permission Form

2020-2021

The Late Arrival / Early Release Program is being established this year to minimize traffic in school hallways, and help promote social distancing. **ANY Student** in grades 9-12 may be eligible if they have a study hall during periods 1, 4, 8, or 10. A student with a 10th period study hall may have a release starting with their ALL at 10:40 am on Block "B" Days. The guidelines for participation in the program include the following:

1. Enrollment in a minimum of 5 classes with a minimum GPA of **2.00**
2. A required class that conflicts with Late Arrival / Early Release will take priority
3. Reliable transportation available to and from school **Everyday!**
4. The student must follow dismissal procedures as provided by the Main Office
 - a. Students enrolled in this program are **NOT** to be on campus before their first class or after their final class period.
5. Permission from a parent/guardian to participate in Late Arrival / Early Release.

To the Student:

I am aware of my responsibilities as a participant in the Late Arrival / Early Release Program. I understand that failure on my part to comply with the guidelines will result in the loss of the privilege and I will be reassigned to a study hall.
